HOW TO "FILE" YOUR ARTICLE

When you file an article, that means you hand it into your editor for review.

- 1) Write your article and complete the contact information on the form.
- 2) Drop your completed article off at the Telling Tales Press Club booth by 4 p.m. on Festival day.
- 3) If you want to take a bit more time to write your article or draw your picture, take it home and then send us a digital copy. Scan, or take a clear picture of the front and back page, and email it to: pressclub@tellingtales.org by Sunday, September 24, 2017.
- 4) By submitting your story to the Telling Tales Press Club, you are automatically a member of the Club and thereby you are giving Telling Tales permission to publish your work.
